Peyton's gluten-free peanut butter chocolate chip cookie recipe

Peyton enjoys trying new recipes and this one has been a favorite with her friends and family. The recipe is flourless, so it's a great addition to bring to a party for anyone who has gluten allergies.

Ingredients


- 1 cup natural peanut butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- 1 large egg, lightly beaten
- ½ cup chocolate chips



Preheat the oven to 350 degrees and place the racks in the upper and lower third of the oven.

In a medium bowl, mix the peanut butter, sugar, vanilla, egg and chocolate chips until well combined. Spoon one tablespoon of the mixture about one inch apart onto ungreased baking sheets.

Bake until golden around the edges, about 10 minutes, switching the position of the sheets halfway through baking. Transfer to racks to cool. Repeat with the remaining dough.
